

The New Synagogue of Netanya has a Kiddush each week, in order to give members and friends the opportunity to socialise.

Below you will see the present bookings and the weeks that are still available. When there is no sponsor, the Synagogue arranges a basic Kiddush.

A suggestion that was implemented a few years ago and is being revived is for a group of friends from the same town, country or age group (e.g. Mancunians, Londoners, second barmitzvah boys or South Africans) to sponsor a Kiddush together.

Every week we cater for the whole congregation, both upstairs and downstairs minyanim. We use ten tables and, as well as the food listed below, each Kiddush incorporates the cost of tablecloths, paperware for wine & soft drinks, plates, serviettes, cutlery and serving dishes. It also includes the wine, water and soft drinks.

During the winter months we offer a self-service bar with hot drinks.

The prices for the Kiddushim are as follows:

1. The Main Kiddush includes two types of herring, three different salads, pickles, crackers, pretzels, burekas, pastries with fancies - this costs 1,600₪
2. The Herring Kiddush includes two types of herring, crackers, pretzels, burekas, pastries - this costs 1,200₪
3. The Cake, wine & soft drinks Kiddush costs 850₪

If a large number of additional guests are expected or some fancier food is added to the above, we may have to charge extra accordingly.

We invite you to share your s'machot (births, engagements, weddings, anniversaries and special birthdays) with your family and the community. Our five Irgun Nashim and Dor Hemshech rotas will prepare everything for you, so that you can be a guest and enjoy the Kiddush with your friends.
